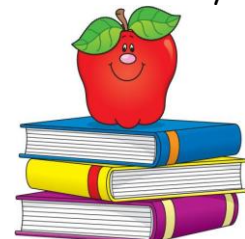

We hosted many visitors for our Veterans Day Assembly this year. Students in 4th and 5th grade were invited to participate in an essay contest sponsored by the Necedah Coughlin-Sanford American Legion Post #277. The American Legion provided resource books to help the students develop their essays. Three winners were recognized at each grade and were awarded \$15 (1st place), \$10 (2nd place), and \$5 (3rd place). The Elementary Parent and Teachers Together Team also pledged a donation to the student project. ABC's of School Success!

Attendance, Behavior, and Coursework are the ABC's of school success! Students who establish regular attendance in elementary school are more likely to maintain their regular attendance in middle and high school. Our Positive Behavior Intervention Support Team is recognizing students who have perfect attendance, those who have only missed one or less than a day and students who have improved their attendance. We all know that illness, funerals, or other events beyond our control can take us away from school or work. That is why we have decided to recognize attendance each month instead of just at the end of the year. Students who are present all day, every day for the month will receive a \$5.00 Cardinal Cash, students who only miss one or less than a day and those who improve their attendance will receive \$2.00 Cardinal Cash to be used in the school store.
