Grade Six, Seven and Eight: NO TRAPPER KEEPERS

- 1 box of 24 yellow #2 pencils (must have pencils at all times)
- 1 eraser or pencil top erasers
- 2 12 count boxes of colored pencils (bring at start of year)
- 1 glue stick (at all times)
- 1 small basket for locker (for pens, pencils, glue, etc.)
- 1 scientific calculator (Texas Instrument Model TI 30 X II S) (please label with student's name)
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex (give to homeroom teacher)
- 2 composition notebooks (for Math Notes-one per semester)
- Single subject spiral notebook for each class (five total per semester)
 - 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 purple, 1 blue, 1 red
- Pocket folder for each class (five total per semester)
 - 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 purple, 1 blue, 1 red
- 1 10W charger and lighting USB cable for iPad Air 2
- 1 plain white tee-shirt (for pride time project)
