Cardinal After-School Program Expectations

ASP = After-School Program

Rules:

- 1. All building/school rules that are in place during the dayside school program apply during Cardinal After-School Program hours... including bus ride home.
- 2. Any student who visits the office due to behavior concerns during the school day may not be allowed to attend the After-School Program that day. A contact with parent will determine result of attendance in program.

Expectations:

3. All students are expected to follow the Cardinal Pride Expectations:

Be Respectful; Responsible, Safe and Honest

- 4. All students are expected to come to program prepared to do work.
 - a. Each student must provide his/her agenda book (grades 3-5) or iPad

 (grades 6-12) to ASP staff so that our staff may check assignments, student work and teacher and parent notations.
 - b. All students are expected to **Show his/her homework if asked to see homework**. Along with providing proof of work completion, accuracy is another component that ASP staff are expected to assist students in striving for.
- 5. All students need to *bring a reading book to ASP each day*. Students are expected to read a minimum of 20 minutes if homework is complete.
- 6. <u>If homework is complete, accurate and the student has read a minimum of 20 minutes and time allows in the remaining reading/homework component, the student will be expected to practice the skills or expectations you have indicated on the enrollment form.</u>

Refusal to follow the rules as stated above will result in following the order of the Cardinal After-School Program Consequence Plan.
